Cedar City OKs **ATV** ordinance

Posted: 7:04 AM- CEDAR CITY -- Cedar City's council voted 4-0 last night to allow off-road vehicles on designated city streets. The Spectrum newspaper reports today that several residents spoke out against the statute, saying it would create noise and safety problems.

The new ordinance -- which goes into effect in 30 days -- will provide direct routes to three **ATV** hot spots: Three Peaks Recreation Area near Enoch, Summit Mountain Road and Kolob Mountain Road.

But Police Chief Bob Allinson issued a warning to **ATV** enthusiasts: Obey the law, or face the consequences.

"It will be strongly enforced," he said, warning that violators risked having their vehicles seized.
